# NOTICE INVITING TENDER FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR ELECTRICAL WORKS AT MUET, SHAHEED Z.A BHUTTO CAMPUS KHAIRPUR MIR'S

Mehran University of Engineering & Technology (MUET), Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Campus, Khairpur Mir's has received funds from the Govt. of Sindh through Provincial ADP for the development of new Infrastructure and Remaining Essential Needs for newly established campus of MUET at Khairpur. Part of these funds will be utilized for execution of electrical works of the campus with the scope, tentative cost and other detail as under.

Govt. of Sindh has approved the following two Schemes for newly established Mehran Scope:

University of Engineering & Technology (MUET), Shaheed Z.A Bhutto Campus at

Khairpur Mir's.

### **Schemes:**

i. Development of New Infra Structure and other Essential Facilities Required for Establishment MUCET, Khairpur Mir's.

ii. Development of Remaining Essential Facilities Required for Establishment of Mehran University College of Engineering & Technology, Khairpur Mir's.

The Civil works for the above scheme are in progress External and Internal Electrification works are to be carried simultaneously with the civil works.

The pre-qualification of Electrical contractors is therefore required for carrying out the electrical works for the years 2014-15 and 2015-16 (Two years)

### 1.0 Section I. Instructions to Bidders/Applicants (ITB).

- Clause 1 The firm/contractor shall enclose the (one original and two copies) of the documents in a sealed envelope which shall:-
  - (a) bear the name and address of the Applicant
  - (b) be delivered by hand or through courier/registered mail to address mentioned in advertisement for pre-qualification or in document and
  - (c) be clearly marked "Application for Pre-qualification of Contractors for Electrical Works at MUET, Shaheed Z.A Bhutto Campus, Khairpur Mir's
- Clause 2 If the envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or pre-maturing opening of the document.
- Clause 3 Document shall be prepared in the English language.
- **Clause 4** Firm/Contractor must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in this document. Any lapse to provide essential information may result in dis-qualification of the firm/contractor.
- Clause 5 Clarification and Modification of Documents (SPP Rule 23)

  Firm/Contractor, who has obtained documents, may request for clarification of contents of the bidding document in writing, and respond to such queries shall be made in writing within three (03) calendar days, provided that they are received at least seven (07) calendar days prior to the date of opening of bid.
- **Clause 6 Addendum:** At any time prior to the deadline for submission of documents, the agency may amend the Pre-qualification Document by issuing addenda. Any addendum issued shall be part of the Prequalification Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the prequalification document.
- Clause 7 Deadline for submission of Documents (SPP Rule 22 & 24): Documents shall be received by the agency at the address Project Director, Mehran University of Engineering & Technology (MUET), Shaheed Z.A Bhutto Campus, Khairpur Mir's, Telephone #: 0243-9280314, not later than the 23-07-2014 up to 13:00 Hrs. The procuring agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of documents by amending the Pre-qualification Document, and in which case all rights and obligations of the Agency and the firms/contractors subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.
- Clause 8 Evaluation (Rule 27(2)): Firm's/Contractor's general and particular experience, personnel and equipment capabilities, and financial position, as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the prescribed forms will be evaluated as per evaluation criteria given in the document. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract. Sub-contractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the firm/contractor compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture.
- Clause 9 Clarification of Pre-qualification Information (Rule 43): To assist in the evaluation of information, the agency may, at its discretion, ask any firm/contractor

for a clarification of any information which shall be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification shall be in writing. If any firm/contractor does not provide clarifications of the information requested by the date and time set in the agency's request for clarification then application of the firm/contractor may be rejected.

Clause 10 Verification of Prequalification Information (Rule 28(1d)): Verification of the information provided by the applicants/firms/contractors in the submissions for prequalification may be made. In case the information is found to be wrong or incorrect in any material way or firm/contractor is found to be lacking in the capability or resources to successfully perform the contract, then it shall not be pre-qualified.
